When you are using a textbook as a source in your References list, you cite it the same way you would cite any other book. Type the first author's name. You type her last name first, followed by a comma, followed by her initials. It looks like this: Koslowski, M. J.

For every in-text citation in your paper, there must be a corresponding entry in your reference list. APA in-text citation style uses the author's last name and the year of publication, for example: (Field, 2005).

Notes: When citing a book in APA, keep in mind: Capitalize the first letter of the first word of the title and any subtitles, as well as the first letter of any proper nouns. The full title of the book, including any subtitles, should be stated and italicized.

When citing online books and eBooks, the publisher location and name are replaced with a web site address. The web site address should be the home page URL of the digital library or publisher. AuthorLastName, FirstInitial. MiddleInitial. (Year of Publication).

### Citing Electronic or Online Books - APA Citation Style ...

Basic book citation format The APA in-text citation for a book includes the author's last name, the year, and (if relevant) a page number. In the reference list, start with the author's last name and initials, followed by the year. The book title is written in sentence case (only capitalize the first word and any proper nouns).

Chicago style has two options for citing sources: you can put citations in footnotes, or you can use parenthetical in-text citations. A Chicago book citation looks slightly different depending on which style you use. Notes and bibliography book citation

### How to Cite a Book in Chicago Style | Format and Examples

Cite the textbook's title within your report's text by using a parenthetical citation. Immediately after the material that you need to cite, use an open parenthesis, the author's last name, a space, and then the page number or page numbers you are citing. For example: (Doe 20-28). This may appear anywhere within a sentence.

When citing a chapter of a book, capitalize as for a journal article title (see 3.9, Titles); do not use quotation marks. Inclusive page numbers of the chapter should be given (see also 3.12.11, Page Numbers or Chapter Number)

Provide all the authors' last names when you first refer to a document with 3-5 authors. Only list the first author with the Latin abbreviation "et al." for any subsequent references.
